Low-Cost Spay/Neuter *Be a responsible pet owner. Pets should be spayed and neutered to prevent more unwanted animals, make a better behaved pet and improve the health of your cat or dog.*

- **SNSI (Spay/Neuter Services of Indiana, Inc.)** www.SpayNeuterServices.org - A nonprofit organization providing low-cost spaying and neutering for dogs and cats in partnership with many Central Indiana veterinary clinics. Year-round program is available to pet owners who meet income requirements; twice a year program is open to all pet owners, regardless of income (February and October).
